



Insurance coverage maintained by the Pasadena Tournament of Roses Association does not extend any protection to the broadcasters or their employees, subcontractors or agents. The Tournament requires that each broadcaster carry the following insurance:

PART A.

Worker's Compensation insurance to cover obligations imposed by Federal and State statutes having jurisdiction of its employees engaged in the performance of the operations, and Employer's Liability insurance with a minimum limit of ONE MILLION DOLLARS (\$1,000,000.00).

PART B.

Commercial General Liability insurance with a minimum combined single limit of ONE MILLION DOLLARS (\$1,000,000.00) each occurrence. The policy shall be written on an occurrence form basis and shall include coverage of bodily injury, broad form property damage, personal injury, blanket contractual and products and completed operations.

PART C.

Commercial Automobile Liability insurance with a combined single limit for bodily injury and property damage of not less than ONE MILLION DOLLARS (\$1,000,000.00) each occurrence, with respect to broadcaster's owned, hired or non-owned vehicles, assigned to or used in performance of the operations.

PART D.

Commercial Umbrella insurance for coverage in Parts B and C above with a combined single limits of not less than FIVE MILLION DOLLARS (\$5,000,000.00) each occurrence.

PART E.

Errors & Omissions/Broadcasters Liability insurance coverage of not less than FIVE MILLION DOLLARS (\$5,000,000) per occurrence and FIVE MILLION DOLLARS (\$5,000,000) aggregate.

PART F.

Broadcaster shall name the Pasadena Tournament of Roses Association and the City of Pasadena, their agents, officials, members and employees as additional insureds with regards to Parts B through E above and shall stipulate that the insurance afforded broadcaster shall be primary insurance and that any insurance carried by the Tournament and the City of Pasadena, their agents, officials, members or employees, shall be excess and not contributory insurance to that provided by the broadcaster. The insurance must also include a waiver of subrogation in favor of the Tournament and the City of Pasadena. The

broadcaster is to obtain a written obligation on the part of the insurance carriers to notify the Tournament, in writing, 30 days prior to any cancellation thereof.

Broadcaster shall provide a certificate of insurance acceptable to the Tournament as evidence that policies providing the required coverage, conditions, and limits as stated above are in full force and effect. The certificate must be sent no later than November 30th to:
